Physical development:

Threading, cutting, weaving, playdough, Fine Motor activities.

Manipulate objects with good fine motor skills.

Draw lines and circles using gross motor movements. Hold pencil/paint brush beyond whole hand grasp.

Cooperation games i.e. parachute games. Climbing - outdoor equipment

Different ways of moving to be explored with children. Acknowledge and praise their efforts.

Provide regular reminders about thorough handwashing and toileting.

Expressive arts and design

Join in with songs; beginning to mix colours, join in with role play games and use resources available for props; build models using construction equipment. Sing call-and-response songs, so that children can echo phrases of songs you sing.

Self-portraits, junk modelling, take picture of children's creations and record them explaining what they did.
