ADMISSIONS POLICY

Haddenham St Mary's Church of England School is a co-educational infant school with an admissions number of 60. The admissions policy for the school follows The Coordinated Admissions Scheme for Primary Schools in the Area of Buckinghamshire County Council Local Authority (the County Scheme). The County Scheme is available on the Buckinghamshire County Council website, www.buckscc.gov.uk

Where eligible applications for admission exceed the number of places available at the main point of admission, the criteria as per The County Scheme will be applied to decide which students to admit. This process is managed by Buckinghamshire County Council.

If any vacancies arise in the Reception class between National Offer Day (April) and 31 August of the same year, first priority will be given to those on the waiting list managed by Buckinghamshire County Council through the County Scheme.

For Reception class admissions between 1 September and 31 August, a waiting list will be maintained by Haddenham St Mary's CE School. If places become available during that period, they will be allocated in waiting list order as per the County Scheme.

In year admissions to KS1 classes will be administered by Haddenham St Mary's CE School.

This Admissions Policy is subject to regular review.
